CTE students earn industry certifications and licenses, postsecondary certificates, associate degrees, bachelor's degrees and higher.

CTE high school students are college and career ready -94% graduate high school and most enroll directly in college.2

CTE associate degrees can pay

\$10,000 more per year than associate degrees in other fields - and can even pay more than bachelor's degrees - while limiting student debt.3




